
Towards Digital Sarawak / Ke Arah Sarawak Digital

Mengawal Kualiti Melalui Audit

Understanding that having an effective audit system is vital for a business' credibility, Trienekens' management structure is supported by a stringent quality audit system. Moreover, the company also observes audits by regulatory bodies and customers according to their varying procedures as ultimately, the company views audits as a tool to improve work practices, assure customer satisfaction and drive project effectiveness.

Having a Safety and Health Committee (SHC) is a requirement under the Malaysian law (Occupational Safety and Health Act 1994) for workplaces with more than 40 workers. The purpose of such a committee is to provide a forum for management and workers to identify and resolve health and safety problems together, as well as to develop and monitor safety systems and procedures. In Trienekens, this committee is referred to as the Health, Safety and Environment Committee (HSEC).

The HSEC is chaired by an authorised Head of Division with a registered Safety and Health Officer (SHO) acting as the Secretary to the HSEC. Committee members consist of both Management and Staff representatives from various departments. The selection of committee members is based on Regulation 7 of the Occupational Safety and Health (Safety and Health Committee) Regulation; that is – new members are nominated by the out-going members, or are appointed by Management.

The HSEC meets at least once every Quarter to discuss and review all occupational safety and health (OSH) programmes and its implementation. In the event of any incidents resulting in loss of life or serious injury, a meeting is called immediately. The HSEC only discusses matters related to workplace safety and health.

Besides playing an active role in promoting OSH at the workplace, the HSEC also assists in the development of OSH rules and operational safety system. The committee also reviews the effectiveness of OSH programmes, conducts joint safety inspections with HSE personnel, and produces inspection reports on any findings.

Pelantikan Komiti Keselamatan dan Kesihatan (SHC) merupakan satu keperluan di bawah undang-undang Malaysia (Akta Keselamatan Pekerjaan dan Kesihatan 1994) untuk tempat-tempat kerja yang mempunyai lebih daripada 40 orang pekerja. Tujuan komiti tersebut adalah untuk menyediakan forum bagi pengurusan dan pekerja bagi sama-sama mengenalpasti dan menyelesaikan masalah-masalah kesihatan dan keselamatan, dan juga membangun dan memantau sistem-sistem serta prosedur-prosedur keselamatan. Di Trienekens, komiti tersebut dikenali sebagai Komiti Kesihatan, Keselamatan dan Alam Sekitar (HSEC).

HSEC dipengerusikan oleh Ketua Bahagian yang diberi kuasa dan Pengawai Keselamatan dan Kesihatan (SHO) berdaftar sebagai Setiausaha kepada HSEC. Ahli-ahli komiti terdiri dari pihak Pengurusan dan wakil-wakil Staf dari pelbagai Jabatan. Pemilihan ahli-ahli Komiti adalah berdasarkan Peraturan 7 di dalam Undang-undang Keselamatan Pekerjaan dan Kesihatan (Jawatankuasa Keselamatan dan Kesihatan); di mana – ahli-ahli baru dicalonkan oleh anggota-anggota yang keluar, atau dilantik oleh Pengurusan.

HSEC bermesyuarat sekurang-kurangnya empat bulan sekali untuk membincang dan menilai semua program-program keselamatan pekerjaan dan kesihatan dan pelaksanaanya. Sekiranya berlaku sebarang kejadian yang melibatkan maut atau kecederaan serius, mesyuarat akan diadakan dengan segera. HSEC hanya membincangkan perkara-perkara berkaitan dengan keselamatan dan kesihatan di tempat kerja.

Selain memainkan peranan aktif mempromosi OSH di tempat kerja, HSEC juga membantu membentuk peraturan-peraturan OSH dan sistem keselamatan operasi. Komiti juga mengkaji semula keberkesanan program-program OSH, menjalankan pemeriksaan keselamatan dengan kakitangan HSE, dan menyediakan laporan tentang sebarang penemuan.

“Green Synergy” Continues To Chart Positive Results

Trienekens’ in-house corporate sustainability campaign, “Green Synergy” recently closed another year on a positive note, with 2017 registering encouraging results in the campaign’s three consolidated programmes (Recycling, Energy Saving and Fuel Efficiency). Aiming to cultivate a culture of environmental care among employees, the programmes provide staff with convenient and easy access to basic recycling facilities and environmental education material, as well as environmental awareness training.

Throughout 2017, the momentum of the office Recycling Programme had continued dynamically in all participating units – Trienekens’ Headquarters (HQ) & Kuching Logistics (KLG), Kuching Integrated Waste Management Park (KIWMP) and Bintulu Branch.

HQ/LG exceeded the target of 5% for mixed plastic with an increment of 7%, while Bintulu Branch shattered the Branch target with an increment of 50% compared to the previous year. In addition, aluminium and steel recycling at both HQ/KLG and KIWMP recorded increments of 32% and 37% respectively; far exceeding the targeted increment of 5% set for year 2017. Meanwhile, the decrease in mixed paper recycling in HQ/KLG, KIWMP and BTU (down by 42%, 25% and 61% respectively) is viewed positively due to the active efforts by all staff to reduce the use of paper in the office.

For the Energy Saving Programme, HQ/KLG, as well as Bintulu Branch achieved lower energy consumption by 4% and 8% respectively; surpassing the reduction target of 2% from 2016. Bintulu Branch had also shown a great improvement in the Fuel Efficiency Programme, where the Branch compactor trucks surpassed the target of -2% KM/L, closing with -29% of KM/L in comparison to the previous year. In addition, KLG hook-lift trucks also managed to meet the targeted fuel consumption reduction for year 2017.

Kempen kelestarian korporat Trienekens, “Sinergi Hijau” yang terdiri gabungan tiga program (Kitar Semula, Penjimatan Tenaga dan Keefisienan Minyak) telah menutup tirai 2017 dengan keputusan positif dan menggalakkan. Bertujuan untuk memupuk budaya sayangkan alam sekitar di kalangan pekerja, program-program tersebut menyediakan akses yang senang dan mudah untuk mengitar semula dan mendapatkan bahan-bahan pendidikan alam sekitar, termasuk kursus kesedaran alam sekitar.

Sepanjang 2017, momentum Program Kitar Semula Pejabat bergerak dengan penuh dinamik di setiap unit – Ibu Pejabat (HQ) & Logistik Kuching (KLG), Kuching Integrated Waste Management Park (KIWMP) dan Cawangan Bintulu.

HQ/LG telah melebihi sasaran pengumpulan plastik dengan kenaikan 7% sementara Cawangan Bintulu memecah sasaran dengan kenaikan 50% berbanding tahun sebelumnya. Tambahan itu, kitar semula aluminium dan besi di HQ/KLG dan KIWMP masing-masing mencatat peningkatan sebanyak 32% dan 37%; melebihi sasaran kenaikan 5% yang ditetapkan untuk 2017. Sementara itu, penurunan dalam kitar semula kertas di HQ/KLG, KIWMP dan BTU (masing-masing turun 42%, 25% dan 61%) dilihat secara positif disebabkan oleh usaha aktif para pekerja mengurangkan penggunaan kertas di dalam pejabat.

Untuk Program Penjimatan Tenaga, HQ/KLG dan Cawangan Bintulu masing-masing mencatat penggunaan tenaga lebih rendah pada 4% dan 8%; melebihi sasaran penurunan sebanyak 2% pada 2016. Program Keefisienan Minyak di Cawangan Bintulu juga menunjukkan peningkatan yang baik di mana trak-trak kompaktor mencapai -29% KM/L, melebihi sasaran -2% KM/L berbanding tahun sebelumnya. Tambahan itu, trak ‘hook-lift’ KLG juga berjaya menepati sasaran penurunan keefisienan bahan apinya dalam 2017.

Transformative Environmental Education

Pendidikan Alam Sekitar Merubah

Where environmental preservation is concerned, Trienekens believes that education is crucial in preparing today's children for the future they will inherit. In this respect, the company hopes to help shape a new generation of society that is ecologically conscious and responsible, through its environmental education initiatives.

Among its efforts are a special solid waste segregation project for selected schools in Kuching which introduces the 5Rs (Reduce, Reuse, Recycle, Rethink and Repair) concept to the programme's participants. Additionally, the programme aims to inculcate habitual sorting of solid waste by engaging both students and staff to practice segregating their school waste from the point-of-generation. Meaningful and creative activities further encourages hands-on practice of the '5 R' principles as the programme includes a year-long calendar of environmental educational events ranging from seminars, workshops and contests for all active programme partners.
