On 17 June 2021, more than 100 Trienekens' staff successfully received their first dose of COVID-19 vaccination in Kuching, which was arranged for by the Sarawak State Government through YB Dato Sri Dr Sim Kui Hian, Minister for Local Government & Housing.

The company also recently participated in the Public-Private Partnership COVID-19 Industry Immunisation Programme (PIKAS) held at tHe Spring shopping mall in Kuching. This programme was co-organized with Ministry of Local Government and Housing Sarawak (MLGH), Ministry of Health (MOH), State Disaster Management Committee (SDMC), COVID-19 Immunisation Task Force (CITF) and KPJ Kuching Specialist being the largest industry vaccination centre in Kuching. Close to 9,000 local industry members were vaccinated during the event, with Trienekens sending 510 persons during the four days event slot including sub-contractors. To date, more than 95% Trienekens' employee have been vaccinated.

Syarikat juga telah menyertai Program Imunisasi Industri Covid-19 Kerjasama Awam-Swasta (PIKAS) yang diadakan dipusat membeli-belah tHe Spring di Kuching. Program ini adalah anjuran bersama Kementerian Kerajaan Tempatan dan Perumahan Sarawak (MLGH), Kementerian Kesihatan (MOH), Jawantkuasa Pengurusan Bencana Negeri (SDMC), Pasukan Petugas Imunisasi COVID-19 (CITF) dan KPJ Kuching Specialist dan ia merupakan pusat vaksinasi industri yang terbesar di Kuching. Hampir 9,000 anggota industri tempatan telah divaksinasi dengan Trienekens menghantar seramai orang 510 dalam acara empat hari tersebut termasuk sub-kontraktor. Hingga kini, lebih 95% daripada pekerja Trienekens telah divaksinasi.

In May 2021, RTM Sarawak featured Trienekens on its popular TV show, Kuppa Kupi to further highlight the importance of a waste collector's role in safeguarding the environment and serving the community.



On 26 March 2021 in conjunction with Earth Hour 2021, the Natural Resources and Environment Board (NREB) Sarawak together with its partners AZAM, Trienekens, WWF-Malaysia and RCE Kuching held the Youth Green X-Change (YGXC) Webinar: Youth Talk Series. The webinar aimed to provide environmental knowledge, skills and opportunity to cultivate environmental stewardship through a series of virtual sharing.

In April 2021, Trienekens presented a waste management talk at Institut Latihan Kementerian Kesihatan Malaysia (Kesihatan Awam) Kuching's webinar, which aimed to educate public health trainees on solid waste management. Presented by Trienekens' Landfill Department Manager, Julian Gabriel Bain, topics included the Integrated Waste Management System (IWMS) in Sarawak, waste treatment technologies and the importance of proper waste management. About 30 trainees attended the webinar.

Titled “Human, Waste and Environment”, the webinar aimed to raise awareness and educate MIA members on best practices in managing solid waste in general and during the COVID-19 pandemic. Presented by Trienekens’ Business Development Senior Executive, Timothy Marimuthu, topics included types of waste, impacts of waste on the environment, Integrated Waste Management System (IWMS) In Sarawak, 3Rs – Reduce, Reuse and Recycling and proper management of waste under the new norm. About 50 MIA members throughout Malaysia attended the webinar.

In pursuing the development of green technology and modern waste management systems, Trienekens (Sarawak) Sdn Bhd actively facilitates and supports cooperation with various stakeholders including industry members, public authorities, community organisations and others. Through initiatives such as information-sharing sessions and other joint programmes, the company hopes to continuously improve its operations and business efficiency.

The Waste Management Association of Malaysia (WMAM)'s training series on 24 March 2021 concerning sustainable landfill management and maintenance, saw more than 30 waste management industry members attend the half-day webinar.

Bearing in mind that the management of solid waste in Malaysia is an important issue and has significant ramifications on the economy and the environment; the webinar aimed to provide an interdisciplinary forum for exchange of information and experiences by fellow industry members, besides allowing participants to learn about various solid waste and recycling efforts and technologies across Malaysia.

# Reviving Recycled Materials Into Incredible Art

## Bahan Kitar Semula Dihidupkan Semula Menjadi Seni Hebat



Local artist Marzuki Jamilah has continued raising awareness on the problems of pollution and wastage. Marzuki views his art as a means to express and preserve local culture and nature.

*Seniman tempatan Marzuki Jamilah terus meningkat kesedaran tentang masalah pencemaran dan pembaziran. Marzuki melihat hasil kerjanya sebagai satu ekspresi dan usaha untuk memelihara budaya tempatan dan alam semulajadi.*

Local artist Marzuki Jamilah has continued raising awareness on the problems of pollution and wastage despite the current COVID-19 pandemic. From scrap metal, used textiles, discarded CDs, used plastics, old newspapers and more; the 3D artist who has been “making new from old” for over a decade is grateful for the increasing interest in his art. Madah Kita recently caught up with Marzuki to find out more about his unique approach to upcycling.

Starting his journey in cartoon illustrations before moving into 3D art and khat calligraphy, 50 year old Marzuki Jamilah had his early education at SK St Thomas and secondary education at SMK Agama Sheikh Haji Othman Abdul Wahab in Kuching. In 2010, he started making traditional dance props and creative craft from used egg cartons, which sparked his interest in exploring other used products as his medium of art.

Currently an administrator at Universiti Teknologi MARA (UiTM), Marzuki explained that the materials used in his art, which is categorized as mixed media, consist all forms of recycled products. “I love that I can create something of quality that is both unique and beautiful from items that would be otherwise thrown away.”

Among his favourite pieces is a 3D Khat calligraphy piece made of old boxes, rope, egg cartons and used polystyrene. “Over the years, I have received offers of thousands of ringgit for it but I have not yet been able to let it go,” he mused. “It was one of my first pieces made from recycled items,” he added.

The father of three is thankful his family fully supports his artistic endeavors. What started as a hobby for him has provided a lucrative income, with most of his clients being private collectors as well as government agencies. His son is also following in his footsteps; and is currently pursuing a Bachelor of Arts (Hons) in Fine Arts at UiTM.

Apart from Khat calligraphy and nature, Marzuki’s art also highlights the Iban community’s culture. “It is an expression and preservation of our local culture and nature through art. That I am able to do it using recycled items is something I am thankful for. Waste can also be treasure,” he explained.

Dari besi buruk, kain terpakai, CD terbuang, plastik terpakai, suratkhabar lama dan sebagainya, seniman 3D yang telah ‘membuat yang baru daripada yang lama’ selama lebih daripada satu dekad bersyukur dengan minat yang ditunjukkan ke atas karya seni beliau. Baru-baru ini, Madah Kita telah berbual dengan Marzuki untuk mengetahui lebih lanjut lagi tentang pendekatan unik beliau di dalam ‘upcycling’.

Sebelum menerokai seni 3D dan khat, Marzuki Jamilah, 50, memulakan perjalanan seninya dalam ilustrasi kartun. Beliau mendapatkan pendidikan awalnya di SK St. Thomas dan pendidikan menengah di SMK Agama Sheikh Haji Othman Abdul Wahab di Kuching. Pada 2010, beliau mula membuat prop tarian tradisional dan kraf kreatif dengan kotak telur terpakai lalu mencetus minat beliau untuk menerokai produk-produk lain sebagai medium seninya.

Marzuki, juga seorang jurutadbir di Universiti Teknologi Mara (UiTM) menjelaskan bahawa bahan yang digunakan di dalam karya seninya, yang dikategorikan sebagai medium campuran, menggunakan semua bentuk produk-produk kitar semula. “Saya amat suka mencipta sesuatu yang berkualiti yang juga unik dan cantik daripada barang-barang yang selalunya dibuang.”

Antara karya kegemaran beliau adalah seni khat 3D yang diperbuat daripada kotak-kotak lama, tali, kotak telur dan polisterin terpakai. “Sejak beberapa tahun ini, saya telah menerima tawaran ribuan ringgit untuk karya tersebut tetapi saya masih belum dapat melepaskannya,” kata beliau. “Ia merupakan antara karya saya yang pertama yang diperbuat daripada bahan-bahan kitar semula,” tambah beliau.



Bapa kepada tiga orang anak itu juga amat berterima kasih kepada keluarganya kerana menyokong kerjaya seninya. Bermula dengan hobi sahaja, ia telah memberikan pendapatan yang lumayan kerana kebanyakan daripada kliennya terdiri daripada pengumpul persendirian dan juga agensi-agensi kerajaan. Anak lelaki beliau juga mengikuti jejak langkahnya; dan kini sedang mengikuti kursus Sarjana Muda Seni Halus (Kepujian) di UiTM.

Selain daripada seni khat dan alam semulajadi, karya seni Marzuki juga menyerlahkan budaya komuniti Iban. “Ia adalah satu ekspresi dan pemeliharaan budaya tempatan dan alam semulajadi kita melalui kesenian. Saya amat bersyukur kerana dapat melakukannya dengan menggunakan bahan-bahan kitar semula. Sisa juga boleh menjadi harta yang berharga,” jelas beliau.
