National Environment Day is observed annually on 21 October in the country to raise environmental awareness among the public and encourage proactive action to protect our precious environment and natural resources.

This year, the state-level celebration focused on the role of schools as catalysts of change and the driving force behind the progression towards environmental sustainability in the state. Trienekens is proud to have collaborated with the Department of Environment (DOE) Sarawak in organising the event, which was officiated at SMK Pending in late October by YB Dr. Hj Hazland bin Abang Hipni, the Deputy Minister for Energy and Environmental Sustainability.

The special event witnessed the announcement of winners of the Environmental Awards for Sustainable Schools (SLAAS), which honoured the long-term sustainability measures taken by schools to not only include environmental preservation as part of their learning experiences but also to nurture the school students into becoming future environmental stewards. Aside from the SLAAS award presentation, the half-day event included exhibitions by various government agencies and school clubs, as well as an electrical and electronic waste collection campaign run by the DOE, Natural Resources and Environment Board (NREB) Sarawak and Trienekens for the teachers, parents and communities in the city.

The Department of Environment (DOE) Sabah recently organised a seminar on Environmental Quality Act (EQA) 1974 - Water Pollution Control and Management of Scheduled Waste, in early November in Kota Kinabalu. Trienekens was honoured to have been invited as one of the key presenters at the two-day seminar which was officiated by DOE Sabah Director, YBrs. Tuan Amirul bin Aripin and attended by 250 participants from numerous industries, including top management, plant managers, consultants, and other stakeholders. Its key objective was to raise awareness on the regulatory compliance required under the EQA 1974 particularly related to water pollution control and management of scheduled waste.

Trienekens Group CEO Stephen Chin spoke at the seminar and shared the company's vast experience as a specialist for scheduled waste management and the operator of the Integrated Waste Management System (IWMS) in Sarawak. The company's extensive Environmental Mainstreaming Tools (EMT) and Guided Self-Regulation (GSR) tools helped the company in ensuring that its operations and processes are in compliance with the EQA 1974 requirements.

An emergency drill is an essential part of workplace safety, as it provides an opportunity for staff to train and build up a strong defence mechanism to mitigate any possible emergency situation. In September, Trienekens together with the Fire and Rescue Department (Bomba), conducted an emergency response drill at Samajaya Free Industrial Zone (FIZ) to evaluate the preparedness and competency of the company's emergency response team in managing the impacts of a road accident and chemical waste spill.

Bomba's HAZMAT team was on site to assess the severity of the simulated chemical spill and deployed to rescue the "victim" before containing and decontaminating the site with the assistance of Trienekens' own Emergency Response Team (ERT).

The combined exercise aimed to provide participants with first-hand experience in handling such an emergency as well as to identify and activate each responder's role in stabilising the potential impacts and risks arising from the incident. Other observers included officers from the Department of Environment (DOE) Sarawak, the Department of Occupational Safety and Health (DOSH) Sarawak, the Ministry of International Trade, Industry and Investment (MINTRED) Sarawak, as well as Trienekens' customers and subcontractors. The session was concluded with a joint discussion to summarise the exercise's accomplishments, weak spots and areas for improvement.

Pasukan HAZMAT Bomba berada di tapak untuk menganalisa kesan simulasi tumpahan kimia dan menyelamatkan "mangsa" yang cedera sebelum mengawal dan mendekontaminasikan tapak dengan sokongan Pasukan Tindak Balas Kecemasan (ERT) Trienekens sendiri.

Latihan bersepada itu bertujuan untuk memberikan pengalaman kepada peserta dalam mengendalikan kecemasan seumpama ini dan mengenal pasti serta mengaktifkan setiap peranan responden dalam menstabilkan potensi impak dan risiko yang timbul daripada insiden tersebut. Pemerhati lain termasuk para pegawai dari Jabatan Alam Sekitar (JAS) Sarawak, Jabatan Keselamatan dan Kesihatan Pekerjaan (JKKP) Sarawak, Kementerian Perdagangan Antarabangsa, Industri dan Pelaburan (MINTRED) Sarawak, serta beberapa orang pelanggan dan subkontraktor Trienekens. Sesi ini diakhiri dengan perbincangan bersama semua pihak yang merumuskan kejayaan, kelemahan dan keperluan penambahbaikan di dalam bidang tertentu.

Continuous Upskilling Through Training

Tingkatkan Kemahiran Berterusan Melalui Latihan

In the extremely competitive job market, companies and their employees must continue prioritising professional growth and continued learning to adapt to today's fast-paced world. Training also promotes efficiency and improves workplace safety through the re-introduction and familiarisation of essential skills. In line with this, the Human Resources Division organised several training programmes to address the different requirements of Trienekens' employees.

Through the training, the group learned about the best practices that can help create an excellent workplace through improvements in quality, health, safety, environment, productivity and subsequently help lower the company's costs, increase its efficiency as well as competitiveness. These practices are based on the SIRIM Standard and Guidelines for Implementing the Green 5S System. The trainees also acquired the necessary knowledge for developing a Green 5S checklist and procedures for the company, which ultimately will create a more sustainable working environment.

In the second half of 2022, Trienekens carried out mandatory training for their compactor teams, including the sub-contractors at the Logistics Depot in Sg. Tapang. Conducted in groups over several sessions, the training was attended by more than 200 drivers and loaders. The training covered a variety of topics, such as safe operation of the vehicles, including the handling of bin lifters, defensive driving practices, accident prevention, and others. Such trainings are essential for the Logistics and Services team, as they help enhance their safety performance and reduce risks of unwanted incidents at work.

Fire safety training at the workplace is crucial, as it provides employees with first-hand experience in managing the risk of fire and familiarising themselves with the relevant procedures to keep injuries or damages to the minimum in the event of such an emergency. A refresher training was recently carried out for Trienekens teams based at its Kuching head office and depot which included the proper use of a fire extinguisher by employing the "PASS" (Pull-Aim-Squeeze-Sweep) method. Aside from that, the team members were also briefed on the various locations of the fire extinguishers inside the building and how to activate the fire alarm in the event of a fire outbreak.

E-Waste Recycling Campaign

Electrical and electronic waste, also known as “e-waste,” must be properly and safely disposed of in order to prevent hazardous materials from being absorbed into the soil and contaminating our eco-system.

In September and October, Trienekens joined forces with the Council of the City of Kuching South (MBKS), Kota Samarahan Municipal Council (MPKS), Serian District Council (MDS), the Natural Resources and Environment Board (NREB) Sarawak and the Department of Environment (DOE) Sarawak to carry out a series of collection campaigns for electrical and electronic waste (BEE) from the public in and around Kuching, Serian and Kota Samarahan. The joint effort kicked off at Mayor Song Swee Guan Park, followed by the La Promenade, Kota Samarahan, Padawan Sports Complex, Siburan and SMK Pending.

The same campaign also took place in Bintulu, organised by Bintulu Port Holdings Berhad (BPHB) in collaboration with Trienekens Bintulu Branch and DOE Sarawak in conjunction with BPHB’s Environmental Week in November at Taman Sri Pelabuhan, Spait, Bintulu.

The Community Solid Waste Segregation and Recycling Pilot Project for Kampung Tunku and Kampung Malaysia Jaya, introduced by the Commission of the City of Kuching North (DBKU) in 2021, is part of the council's long-term plan to introduce a dedicated single-stream recycling collection system in areas under its jurisdiction while promoting waste minimization and sustainable living among city folk, further boosting the recycling rate in Kuching City.
