2023 signifies a remarkably amazing year for Trienekens, as it recently won not one but two prestigious awards for its outstanding performance in safety and environmental sustainability. The first award, the Shell Malaysia Safety Award - Gold Safety Award presented during a ceremony hosted by Shell Malaysia in May recognised Trienekens' high performance

and key achievements in health, safety, security and environmental (HSSE) initiatives within its operations. The award was presented under the Downstream and Integrated Gas Category, which was among the top three categories alongside the Upstream and Corporate Categories.

2023 merupakan tahun yang luar biasa untuk Trienekens, kerana ia telah memenangi bukan satu tetapi dua anugerah berprestij di atas kecemerlangan prestasi keselamatan dan kelestarian alam sekitarnya. Anugerah ini melambangkan komitmen Trienekens di dalam mengekalkan standard tertinggi di dalam amalan keselamatan dan dedikasinya dalam pelindungan alam sekitar.

Anugerah pertama, Anugerah Keselamatan Emas, yang disampaikan di dalam satu majlis Anugerah Keselamatan Shell Malaysia (SMSA), anjuran Shell Malaysia pada bulan Mei telah mengiktiraf prestasi dan pencapaian-pencapaian inisiatif HSSE Trienekens yang tinggi dalam operasinya. Anugerah tersebut adalah di bawah Kategori Gas Hilir dan Bersepada, yang merupakan antara tiga kategori teratas di samping Kategori Huluan dan Korporat.

Trienekens and Shell Study Potential of Plastic Waste Chemical Recycling

Trienekens (Sarawak) Sdn Bhd and Shell Singapore Pte. Ltd. (SSPL) signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) in May to potentially collaborate on chemical recycling of plastic waste. It is an advanced form of recycling that breaks down plastic waste into its basic chemical building blocks that are often converted to create new plastics, fuels or other chemical products.

The partnership aims to discover the potential of chemical recycling, both technologically and economically in efforts to spur the circularity of plastic waste and advance circular economy with the aim to identify an alternative source of energy and secondary raw materials that can add value to our current economy.

The MoU exchange ceremony, witnessed by Sarawak's Deputy Minister for Energy and Environmental Sustainability, YB Dr. Hazland Abang Hipni at Trienekens' Headquarters at Jalan Sungai Tapang, Kuching, marked a significant development in the region's sustainability efforts as it charts the way forward towards establishing a circular economy through sound technology and innovation that provides sustainable plastic waste management solutions.

The MoU documents were exchanged between Trienekens Group CEO, Stephen Chin and Country Chair of Shell Malaysia and Senior Vice President, Upstream Malaysia, Siti Sulaiman.

Trienekens (Sarawak) Sdn Bhd dan Shell Singapore Pte. Ltd. (SSPL) telah menandatangani satu Memorandum Persefahaman (MoU) pada bulan Mei untuk mengkaji potensi kerjasama pengitaran semula kimia sisa plastik. Ia merupakan satu kaedah terkini dalam pengitaran semula di mana plastik dipecahkan kepada blok binaan kimia asas yang boleh diubah menjadi plastik baharu, bahan api atau produk-produk kimia lain.

Kerjasama ini bertujuan untuk menerokai potensi pengitaran semula kimia dari kedua-dua aspek teknologi dan ekonomi sebagai satu usaha mendorong kitaran semula sisa plastik dan memajukan ekonomi kitaran di mana sumber tenaga alternatif dan bahan mentah sekunder dapat dikenal pasti untuk meningkatkan nilai ekonomi semasa kita.

Compliance with local and global safety and environmental standards as well as regulations is paramount in the operations of scheduled waste management to ensure the safety and health of the waste generators, service providers and the public at large.

Trienekens recently participated in two major seminars on the Environmental Quality (Scheduled Waste) Regulations 2005, organised by the Department of Environment (DOE) Sarawak in Bintulu in March, followed by Kuching in May.

Officiated by DOE Sarawak Director Tuan John ak Rampai, the main objective of both seminars was to raise awareness and knowledge about the laws and requirements under the Environmental Quality Act (EQA) 1974, particularly on the management of scheduled waste. Among the attendees were representatives from related government agencies and authorities and other stakeholders from various industries such as oil and gas, palm oil, SMEs and other local scheduled waste generators.

At both seminars, Trienekens as one of the invited speakers, shared on the company's experiences, sustainability initiatives and regulatory compliance journey as well as in-depth overview on the way forward in the handling, treatment and disposal of scheduled waste in Sarawak.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Training/ Latihan Alat Pelindung Diri (PPE)

A Qualitative Respirator Fit Test was recently conducted by Trienekens' operations team at the Kuching Integrated Waste Management Park (KIWMP) and the scheduled waste team at the Bintulu Branch. Qualitative testing is a subjective method that relies on senses such as taste and smell to detect leakage from the user's respirator. As required by the Department of Occupational Safety and Health (DOSH), fit testing must be done before a user wears a mandatory respirator on the job. Based on current guidelines, it must be assessed annually.

Using Art to Promote Sustainability

“The Turtle in the Ocean” art installation designed by Kuching-born artist and entrepreneur, Daphne Siaw recently entered the Malaysia Book of Records (MBR) for ‘The Biggest Straw Art Installation in Malaysia’ measuring 6 metres wide and 3 metres tall and made out of 420,000 waste plastic straws! Daphne was presented with an appreciation certificate at the “Make Climate Cool Again” event launched by the Council of the City of Kuching South (MBKS), Naked Wonders and Natural Resources and Environment Board (NREB) Sarawak in conjunction with Earth Day which is observed annually on 22 April.

“The Turtle in the Ocean” was designed to illustrate the magnitude of plastic waste problem and to raise awareness as well as encourage self-reflection about its long-term impact on our planet. Daphne believes art can touch emotions and cross language and cultural barriers, making it the perfect medium for raising environmental and climate change awareness.

Daphne’s other meaningful works include recycled plastic installations for The Waterfront Hotel, Borneo Talk, Bdari, and 1Utama Shopping Centre. Her most cherished art piece was the one she did for the Radiotherapy Unit (RTU) of Radiation and Oncology Service of Sarawak General Hospital (SGH) in honour of her mother whom she lost due to cancer.
